Passengers will receive a ticket upon boarding in Manitowoc on the morning shuttles and will need to keep /show the ticket to board the bus for the afternoon / evening return trip to Manitowoc. Without a return ticket when boarding at Whistling Straits, the return ride will cost \$10.
