### **Neshotah Beach & Beach House Shelter**

This area includes a beautiful Lake Michigan sand beach with areas for swimming and launching jet skis. The Beach House is home to a bathhouse/changing area, and restrooms. The shelter can be rented for private parties & picnics. Located at 500 Zlatnik Drive.

### **Vietnam Veterans Park**

This is great place for baseball or softball tournaments. Recreational leagues are held here in June and July. Located at 1300 35th Street.

### **Neshotah Park - Jaycee & New Shelters**

Each shelter is available for rental. Neshotah Park is home to play equipment; volleyball, basketball & horseshoe courts; restroom facilities; picnic areas with tables & grills; and a softball diamond. Located at 2111 Pierce Street.

### **Picnic Hill**

This unique area features walking trails as well as a small disc golf course. Located adjacent to Walsh Field at 22nd & Polk Streets.

### **Riverside Park Shelter, Skate Park & Dog Park**

This park includes a rentable fully enclosed shelter/restroom facility. There is also play equipment, basketball courts, a fenced dog park, and a skate park. Located at 1423 River Place.

### **Vet's Park**

This park includes a rentable shelter with restroom facilities, play equipment, basketball & volleyball courts. Located at 18th & Madison Streets.

### **Washington Park**

This park opened in 2004 and includes a shelter/restroom, playground equipment, and a walking trail. Located at 2909 Adams Street.

### **Walsh Field**

This recreational field includes a rentable shelter & bathroom facilities. The stadium style bleachers make it a great place for viewing local baseball, football, and soccer games, as well as the annual 4th of July Fireworks display. Located at 22nd & Polk Streets.

### **Zander Park Shelter**

This park includes a rentable shelter/restroom, with play equipment, picnic areas, and basketball courts. Located at 1406 Parkway Blvd.

## MANITOWOC COUNTY PARKS/PICNIC AREAS

Park Season Dates: April 1 to October 31

Park Hours: 6am to 11pm (Cherney Maribel Caves and Walla Hi close at 8pm)

### Cherney Maribel Caves

Cherney Maribel Caves County Park occupies 75 acres on the West Twin River north of the Village of Maribel in the Town of Cooperstown. A rugged cliff line, generally paralleling the river, separates the gently rolling, partially wooded upland area from the wooded lowland adjacent to the river. The foot of the cliff line contains small caves and openings in the rock layers.

**Location:** County Highway R

### Fischer Creek Conservation Area

Fischer Creek Conservation Area is the most recent addition to the Manitowoc County Park System. This 160 acre site was purchased by the State of Wisconsin using Stewardship money along with a contribution from Manitowoc County. The property is owned by the State and developed and maintained by the County.

**Location:** County Highway LS

### Horse Shoe Lake

Manitowoc County maintains an 8.5 acres park at Horseshoe Lake. An attractive picnic area with grills, tables and playground equipment has been developed on the hillside northwest of the parking lot. A picnic area with a grill and a small shelter and toilet are located near the parking lot on the lower level. The lake access has a pier, which is used for both launching and fishing. This 19-acre lake offers good rainbow trout fishing as well as largemouth bass, crappie, bluegill, perch and northern pike. Use of motors on this lake is prohibited.

**Location:** County Highway XX

### Long Lake

Long Lake County Park occupies 4.5 acres on the northeast shore of this 117 acre lake. The park provides public access for boating and fishing and has been developed into an attractive picnic area. Facilities located here include a concrete boat launch ramp, pier, fishing pier, picnic tables, grills, playground equipment and a toilet building. A small open area is available for recreation activities.

**Location:** Boot Lake Road, Town of Rockland

### Lower Cato Falls

The park is very scenic with its wooded hills, rock outcroppings and a wide variety of trees and vegetative cover. The Manitowoc River, which forms the northern boundary of the park, flows through a narrow gorge that has unique rock formations and a waterfall area. Park visitors have an impressive panoramic view of the river from various scenic overlooks.

Picnicking, hiking and nature trail walks are among the most popular activities here at Lower Cato Falls. Facilities at the park include grills, picnic tables, toilets, playground equipment, and a disc golf course. Four wooden staircases leading from the top of the bluff to the river were constructed to provide greater ease in negotiating the steep slopes of the river bank. The recent removal of the dam at Manitowoc Rapids has allowed the Manitowoc River to be managed as a rainbow trout fishery. This park offers approximately 2,040 feet of river frontage

**Location:** County Highway JJ

### **Point Creek Conservation Area**

Point Creek Conservation Area is the most recent addition to the Manitowoc County Park System, which is located in the Town of Centerville in the southeastern portion of Manitowoc County. The property consists of 39 acres of woodlands, meadows, estuary, wetlands and coastal bluffs with approximately 2,800 feet of high bluff bank and associated Lake Michigan shore. Point Creek defines the southern boundary of the property, which includes over 1,000 feet of riparian corridor.

**Location:** County Highway LS

### **Silver Lake**

The wayside park and boat launch ramp at Silver Lake have been developed on 12 acres of land leased to Manitowoc County by the Franciscan Sisters of Christian Charity of Holy Family Convent. The park offers an excellent family picnic area, complete with a shelter, grills, tables and toilet building. A concrete boat ramp and pier are available for launching canoes, sailboats and rowboats. Motors, except for electric motors are restricted from the lake by Town ordinance. The lake itself is 55 acres in size, almost divided into two separate lakes, by a long narrow neck located in the middle. The wooded margins of both sections of the lake and Silver Creek, offers the delights of bird watching, especially at the time of the spring and fall migration of warblers.

**Location:** U.S. Highway 151, Town of Manitowoc Rapids

### **Walla Hi**

Walla Hi County park is located approximately 4 miles east of Kiel in southwestern Manitowoc County. The park, consisting of 160 acres, was acquired in 1977.

The park features a scenic drive through the park along with several trails winding through the beautiful kettle moraine landscape. One of the park's most appealing characteristics is the great diversity of environments, varying from heavily wooded areas to large open expanses. The park also contains several small springs flowing into crystal clear streams.

Fishing, hiking and picnicking are among the most popular activities in Walla Hi, with hiking trails also ideally suited for cross country skiing during the winter months. Facilities include excellent family picnic areas, grills, picnic tables, playground equipment and toilet facilities.

**Location:** South Cedar Lake Road

## MANITOWOC COUNTY BOAT ACCESSES

### **Bullhead Lake**

Bullhead Lake, consisting of 67 acres of surface water, is said to contain one of the best fish populations in Manitowoc County. The positive effect of shoreland zoning is evident as one travels by boat. The parking area at the public access can accommodate 30 car/trailer units. The access also has a concrete ramp, port-a-pier and toilet building.

Bullhead Lake is known for nice size walleyes and pan fish such as perch, crappies and bluegills. Operating restrictions on motorboats and water skiing are posted at the access.

**Location:** County Highway JJ, Town of Rockland

### **Carstens Lake**

Carstens Lake is approximately 20 acres in size and reaches a maximum depth of about 30 feet. The public lake access has a parking space 15 car/trailer units. Several years ago, the Department of Natural Resources poisoned off the lake and a fish weir was installed within the inlet stream to block off the spawning runs of rough fish from Lake Michigan.

Facilities include a port-a-pier and toilet building provided by the Manitowoc County Fish and Game Association. A picnic area has been recently added to this access.

Adult northern pike and bass have been planted to restock the lake. Use of motors, except electric motors, is prohibited.

**Location:** Carstens Lake Road, Town of Newton

### **Cedar Lake**

Cedar Lake is a 139 acre lake with a maximum depth of 21 feet. This is the largest inland lake in Manitowoc County. This access was developed in the early 1980's by Manitowoc County. Because of the steep slope to the water's edge, the access road and launching area were blacktopped shortly after development. A one acre parking lot was developed on land provided by the Kiel Fish and Game Association across Rockville Road, southwest of the access. This access also offers a picnic area near the parking lot, a port-a-pier for easier access to the lake and a toilet building.

There are many species of fish found in Cedar Lake, such as bass, northern pike and pan fish (including perch, crappies and bluegills). Operating restrictions on motorboats and water skiing are posted at the access.

**Location:** Loius Corners Road, Town of Schleswig

### **English Lake**

English Lake is an approximately 51-acre lake. The maximum depth of this lake is 85 feet, making it the deepest lake in Manitowoc County. The public access has a concrete boat launch ramp with a 50 foot port-a-pier. Other facilities available are a small shelter, picnic areas with grills and a toilet building. There are parking spaces to accommodate 15 car/trailer units.

This lake is known for nice size walleyes, largemouth bass and pan fish. Operating restrictions on motorboats and water skiing are posted at the access.

**Location:** Brunner Road, Town of Newton

### **Gass Lake**

Gass Lake is 6 ½ acres in size and has a maximum depth of 24 feet. It is a spring fed lake with no shoreline development. The access road leading to the public boat launch facility and parking area are blacktopped. Parking barriers and a gate over the entrance road have been installed. This access has a combination fishing and launching port-a-pier with a small picnic area containing a table and grill. Parking space is available for 8 car/trailer units. The access is barricaded during the winter because of the steep access road.

This lake is best known for largemouth bass, but pan fish including bluegill, perch and crappies are also found here. Use of motors, except electric motors, are prohibited

**Location:** Gass Lake Road, Town of Newton

### **Harpt Lake**

Harpt Lake reaches a maximum depth of 49 feet. Parking for 4 car/trailer units is provided at the public access to this 20 acre lake. The lake is known for its large size walleye, largemouth bass and black crappie. Northern pike, perch, bluegill and rock bass populations are also found here. Use of motors, except for 1 hp electric motors, is prohibited. An additional boat launch ramp, fishing piers and swimming beach are located on the east side of the lake at the Larrabee Sportsman's Club.

**Location:** North Lake Road, Town of Gibson

### **Hartlaub Lake**

Hartlaub Lake covers 38 acres and reaches a maximum depth of 59 feet. Parking for 8 car/trailer units is provided at the public access. The steep access road and parking area has been blacktopped and like Gass Lake, the access road is barricaded during the winter months. Due to the soft bottom of the lake, a 60 foot port-a-pier has been installed for easier access.

The lake is known for northern pike, bass, walleye and pan fish. Use of motors, except electric motors, is prohibited.

**Location:** Hartlaub Lake Road, Town of Newton

### **Pigeon Lake**

The public access at Pigeon Lake has parking space for 10 car/trailer units, a concrete boat ramp and outdoor lighting to assist in boat launching during the hours of darkness. The 77-acre lake is a popular spot for water skiing and boating, which are regulated by a town ordinance and posted at the access. The access and parking area are blacktopped with a port-a-pier for easier access to the lake. The facility also has a toilet building.

The lake is best known for walleye and northern pike, but also contains largemouth bass, white bass and trout.

**Location:** Pigeon Lake Road, Town of Liberty

### **Manitowoc River Access**

Manitowoc River access is a 2 ½ acre public access located on the Manitowoc River just west of CTH R bridge in Manitowoc Rapids. This facility gives fishermen the ability to fish off the banks of the Manitowoc River. This site has ample parking, toilet building, trails to shoreline and open space for picnic area. The river holds trout, salmon, northern pike, catfish and smallmouth bass.

**Location:** County Highway R, Town of Manitowoc Rapids

### **Shoe Lake**

Shoe Lake, which is 9 acres in size, has a maximum depth of 34 feet. A picturesque lake with very little shoreline development, it offers big bluegill, largemouth bass and an occasional northern pike. The public access has 105 feet of frontage and can accommodate 15 car/trailer units. A port-a-pier was recently added to make lake access much easier. Green sunfish, pumpkinseed, black crappie, suckers and bullhead also abound here. Motor boating is prohibited; but, the lake, surrounded with dense forest growth, is a perfect place for row boating and canoeing.

**Location:** County Highway JJ, Town of Schleswig

### **Spring Lake**

Spring Lake is 8 acres in size and has a maximum depth of 24 feet. Parking spaces for 8 car/trailer units is provided at the lake access. Several years ago, a combination launch and fishing pier was installed. Good sized northern pike and largemouth bass have been taken by fishermen. Bluegill are also found in this lake. Motor boats are prohibited.

**Location:** Spring Lake Road, Town Meeme

### **Tuma Lake**

Tuma Lake is 15 acres in size and has a maximum depth of 30 feet. The public access has parking space for 4 car/trailer units. This lake provides good walleye fishing, as well as bass, bluegill, perch, and northern pike. Use of motors, except for 1 hp electric motors, is prohibited.

**Location:** Harpt Lake Road, Town of Gibson

### **Weyers Lake**

Weyers Lake, which is 6 acres in size, has a maximum depth of 32 feet. A picturesque lake with very little shoreline development, it offers big bluegill, largemouth bass and an occasional northern pike. The public access has 46 feet of frontage and can accommodate 5-8 car/trailer units. A port-a-pier was recently added to make lake access much easier. Green sunfish, pumpkinseed, black crappie, suckers and bullhead also abound here. Motor boating is prohibited; but, the lake, surrounded with dense forest growth, is a perfect place for row boating and canoeing.

### **West Twin River**

West Twin River public access is a 2 acre public access located on a wide bend in the river near Shoto. High water levels of Lake Michigan have once again inundated about half of the access which is located in a floodplain. To make the area more usable, additional gravel was added to the access road and parking area. The site includes a small picnic area, concrete ramp and a port-a-pier to make access to the river much easier. Trout, salmon, northern pike, catfish and bass may be taken from the river. The public access compliments the Shoto Conservation Club located to the west.

**Location:** County Highway VV, Town of Two Rivers

### **Wilke Lake**

Wilke Lake covers 97 acres and has a maximum depth of 22 feet. The public access has parking space for 10 car/trailer units and a turn-around area for easier access to the lake. Wilke Lake access also offers a picnic area with grills, a concrete ramp with a port-a-pier and a toilet building.

This lake is best known for its largemouth bass, northern pike and walleye. Other species of fish found at Wilke Lake include bluegill and perch. Operating restrictions on motorboats and water skiing are posted at the access.

**Location:** County Highway JJ, Town of Schleswig

### **Indian Creek Park**

This natural prairie along the Little Manitowoc River provides a beautiful backdrop for Manitowoc's newest championship 18 hole disc golf course. Multiple tee areas for beginners and professionals. Dog friendly park! Located at North 8th Street and Albert Drive, Manitowoc, WI

### **Lower Cato Falls County Park**

Manitowoc County's newest disc golf course opened in June of 2010! Lower Cato Falls County Park has been a beautiful park for fishing, picnicking and hiking for many years. Recently the county parks dept., local businesses, disc golf volunteers and the Transitions Advisory Committee of the Chamber of Manitowoc County have teamed up to create a championship layout disc golf course. Both professional and amateur golfers will share the fairways with many of the same elements that make Silver Creek Park in Manitowoc one of the most popular courses in the state of Wisconsin. Located at County Highway JJ, Clarke Mills, WI

### **Lakeshore Technical College**

A nicely groomed and well maintained 18-hole disc golf course weaves through the trees and across the meadows of the Cleveland campus. It is free and open to the public. LTC is an alcohol-free campus. Located at 1290 North Avenue, Cleveland, WI

### **Picnic Hill**

A quiet and natural 9 hole disc golf course that weaves through the woods. The mature forest and undergrowth offers a beautiful nature experience. Look for basket #1 located under the water tower. Located at Polk St & 23rd St, Two Rivers WI 54241

### **Silver Creek Park**

Disc golfers testify that Silver Creek Park offers a challenging, balanced and fun disc golf course for all skill levels. Features include Silver Creek winding through the course, Lake Michigan lookouts and beach front fairways. Open all year round. Located at South 10th Street, one block South of Viebahn Street), Manitowoc, WI
