Nancian Hall’s winning photo of *Serenity at Rogers Street Fishing Village* was selected by the MAVCB marketing committee to be featured on the front cover of the bureau’s 2011 Manitowoc-Two Rivers Discovery Guide. Other winning photos entered in the contest will be used throughout the publication and for a variety of promotional uses. Over 55,000 copies of the Discovery Guide are distributed locally, regionally and throughout the Midwest and mailed out as the first response piece to MAVCB generated advertising.
