

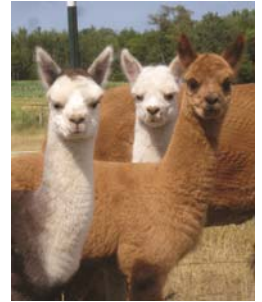
# Two Rivers...City of Museums and Birthplace of the Ice Cream Sundae!

**Point Beach Energy Center** – Visitors of ALL ages will enjoy exploring the ENERGY EXPERIENCE at the Point Beach Energy Center. Open to group tours with advance reservations. FREE. Or visit **LondonDairy**



**Alpacas & Fiber Studio Gift Store** – Tour a century old farm that now raises exotic, soft alpacas, and enjoy shopping in the unique gift shop filled with items made from the alpaca's non-allergenic, durable fiber. Open to group tours with advance reservations. FREE.

**Rogers Street Fishing Village & Museum with 1886 Lighthouse** – This museum village and heritage park features artifacts of famous shipwrecks on Rawley Point. Storyteller on site describes the sinking of the Rouse Simmons Christmas Tree Ship, Two Rivers' most noted shipwreck. (\$4/person, children 16 and under \$2, tour escort and driver complementary). Open Memorial Day – Mid October.



12 noon Enjoy lunch with a scenic view of Lake Michigan at the **Lighthouse Inn**; grab a gourmet burger at **Waverly Inn Pub & Pizza** in historic Downtown Two Rivers; or dine at **Kurtz's**, a historic German pub and deli specializing in world famous beers.

**Washington House & Berner's Ice Cream Parlor** – Warm 1850 hotel, historic saloon (nonalcoholic) and museum. Friendly costumed volunteers available for guided tours. Berners' old time ice cream parlor and soda fountain serves up delicious treats while commemorating the invention of the ice cream sundae right here in Two Rivers. FREE. Visit the **Hamilton Wood Type Museum** – Vintage machinery and original patterns for multi-lingual, international production of wood type (\$5 admission fee).



3 pm

**The Historic Farm Museum** - Displays antique tractors, vintage farm equipment, miscellaneous tools and a farmhouse display from the early 1900s. FREE.

5 pm

Enjoy shopping in downtown Two Rivers at **Schroeder's**, one of the nation's oldest department stores; **Unique Flying Objects**, colorful kites and flags of all shapes and sizes; or **Inman Jewelers** for exclusive Two Rivers souvenirs. On your way to or from Two Rivers stop by **The Honey Pot**, a delightful themed gift shop.
