The Wisconsin Maritime Museum

The Wisconsin Maritime Museum is certainly a treasure on the Lake Michigan Coast. Always reinventing itself, the museum offers permanent displays highlighting Manitowoc County's Maritime heritage including a completely restored WWII Submarine, the U.S.S. Cobia. Guided tours are given hourly, or stay the night aboard the sub with your scout troop or family. This year they are taking it a step further and offering temporary exhibits by



the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Association (Treasures of NOAA's Ark and Wisconsin's Underwater Treasures) and River Bluffs by modeler and boat builder Jeff Moses. Both exhibits begin on March 14, 2015.
